

Student Dress Requirements

On any school day, no offensive or political messaging is to be present on any clothing or accessories.

GRADES 1-8 MONDAY - THURSDAY DRESS CODE:

Students in Grades 1-8 wear chino-style pants or mid-thigh length or longer skirts or shorts of chino material. Pants, skirts, or shorts must be solid khaki, navy blue, gray, or black, along with any solid-colored collared, button-down, or turtleneck shirt.

<u>Solid-colored</u> fleece, sweaters, crew neck sweatshirts, and jackets may be worn inside the building. A collared shirt must be worn underneath these items if they do not have a collar.

TLS branded sweatshirts or hoodies are also acceptable on Monday - Thursday, but hoods must be kept down while students are inside.

Unless TLS branded, all clothing items should be devoid of pictures or patterns. Leggings must be worn under clothing and cannot be worn alone as pants. Outerwear for recess and carline need not follow the solid-color rule, but jackets or sweaters worn inside the building must be solid-colored.

Any solid-colored, jewel-necked, or collared dress/jumper is acceptable. Belts must be worn if belt loops are visible. Straight hemmed shirts such as polos or blouses may be worn outside of the waistband but must be appropriately sized. All button-down shirts or those with long shirttails must be tucked in.

GRADES 1 - 8 FRIDAY UNIFORM DRESS:

Students in Grades 1-8 participate in TLS Friday Dress. The dress uniform is worn every Friday and on other designated days as announced. Students may select from the combinations described below:

Friday Dress Combinations:

Combo 1:

<u>Top</u> - White button-down or polo style shirt; Green, Black, or White cardigan or sweater (sweaters to be purchased from <u>Lands' End</u> or <u>Shaheens</u>)

<u>Bottom</u> - Gray or TLS plaid skirt, Gray or TLS plaid jumper, solid tights/leggings allowed; (skirts to be purchased from <u>Lands' End</u> or <u>Shaheens</u>)

Combo 2:

<u>Top</u> - White button-down, TLS tie (purchased from TLS Tack Shop), Navy blue blazer (worn from November - March); shirt tucked in

Bottom - Khaki dress slacks, khaki dress shorts mid-thigh length or longer, belt

Combo 3:

<u>Top</u> - White button-down, Navy blue blazer worn at all times of the year; shirt tucked in <u>Bottom</u> - Gray dress slacks, gray dress shorts mid-thigh length or longer; belt

PRESCHOOL DRESS MONDAY-FRIDAY:

Preschool dress code is the same **Monday-Friday**. Preschool does not participate in TLS Friday Dress. Preschoolers may wear solid khaki, navy, gray, black pants/shorts/skirts, and **any** solid-colored collared shirt or dress (dresses **do not** need collars). Acorn students will follow the daily solids; however, collared shirts are **not**

required. All preschoolers may wear patterned tights under dresses/skirts/shorts. Patterned tights are allowed in Preschool only. Acorns students will follow the daily uniform in solid colors but are not required to have collared shirts. Belts are discouraged in Preschool, and shirttails do not need to be tucked in.
